Study) is a 3 year observational study
which aims to look into the safety and
effectiveness of antipsychotic therapies
and other treatment approaches in the
management of Parkinson's disease (PD). It
will likewise look into the clinical, economic
and humanistic outcomes of the treatment

approaches for both patient and caregivers in the real world medical practice setting.

The study involves answering questionnaires during standard care of the patient.

Patients with PD, who are able to read and understand English, who are willing and able to sign an informed consent can be enrolled for this study. (NCT03152292)
